SCHOOL DISTRICT SETS MEETING AND WORKSHOPS TO DISCUSS SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

The Berkeley Unified School District has announced a series of Board of Education Workshops and a Community Meeting to discuss the work of the Superintendent's Task Force on School Organization. (The first Board of Education Workshop, originally scheduled on Thursday, November 5, 1992 has been cancelled.)

The Board of Education Workshops will be held at 7:30 p.m. at the Franklin School Cafetorium, 1150 Virginia Street, on the following dates:

- · Monday, November 16, 1992
- · Monday, November 23, 1992
- · Monday, November 30, 1992

A Community Meeting to discuss the work of the Task Force has also been scheduled for Tuesday, November 24, 1992 at 7:30 p.m. at LeConte School, 2241 Russell Street.

The Superintendent's Task Force on School Organization is made up of representatives from the district unions, the P.T.A., and district advisory committees, members of the Berkeley Unified School District administration, and interested citizens appointed by the Board of Education. The Task Force is studying and developing policy options regarding integration, grade configuration, school zoning, magnet schools, transportation, and school size. It will be making recommendations to the Board in January, 1993.

These meetings and workshops are a chance for interested citizens to express their ideas to the Task Force and the Board of Education regarding these issues.
