Malcolm X Parents,

Tonight and next Wednesday night at the BUSD School Board Meetings may be your last chance to speak in support of our current grade configuration.

Despite the fact that our site committee and the site committees of our feeder schools have consistently recommended that we at Malcolm X remain a 4-6 school, several developments in the Measure A process seem to be in direct conflict with our recommendations.

1) The superintendent has stated that a "mosaic" of grade configurations would not be feasible.

2) A new K-4, 5-8 configuration which would supposedly rebuild Malcolm X at the East Campus site (and turn our current site into an Administration building) is still being considered.

3) Other school communities that support a K-5 configuration have spoken often at the Board Workshops. Our Malcolm X communities are not being heard.

We need strong voices in support of our 4-6 program at Malcolm X NOW.

Please take a minute to call your school board representatives and let them know your opinion on this important issue, or come to the School Board Meeting tonight Wednesday, December 8th at 7 o'clock.
