CURRENT SYSTEM White 14% (152 of 1088) Black 19% (270 of 1395)

PROPOSED SYSTEM White 18% (198 of 1088) Black 54% (755 of 1395)

Bussing numbers are such a function of assumptions. The numbers above are neither the actual numbers who ride busses, nor are they the number who are politically "bussed" - i.e. kids who are transported out of their neighborhoods for the sake of desegregation. I still think that either of those is more valid. The former is what I calculated last Friday night; the latter can be calculated only by several hours of analysis and programming. The numbers above are sort of a hybrid, but they are what you and Monica seek as best I can understand.

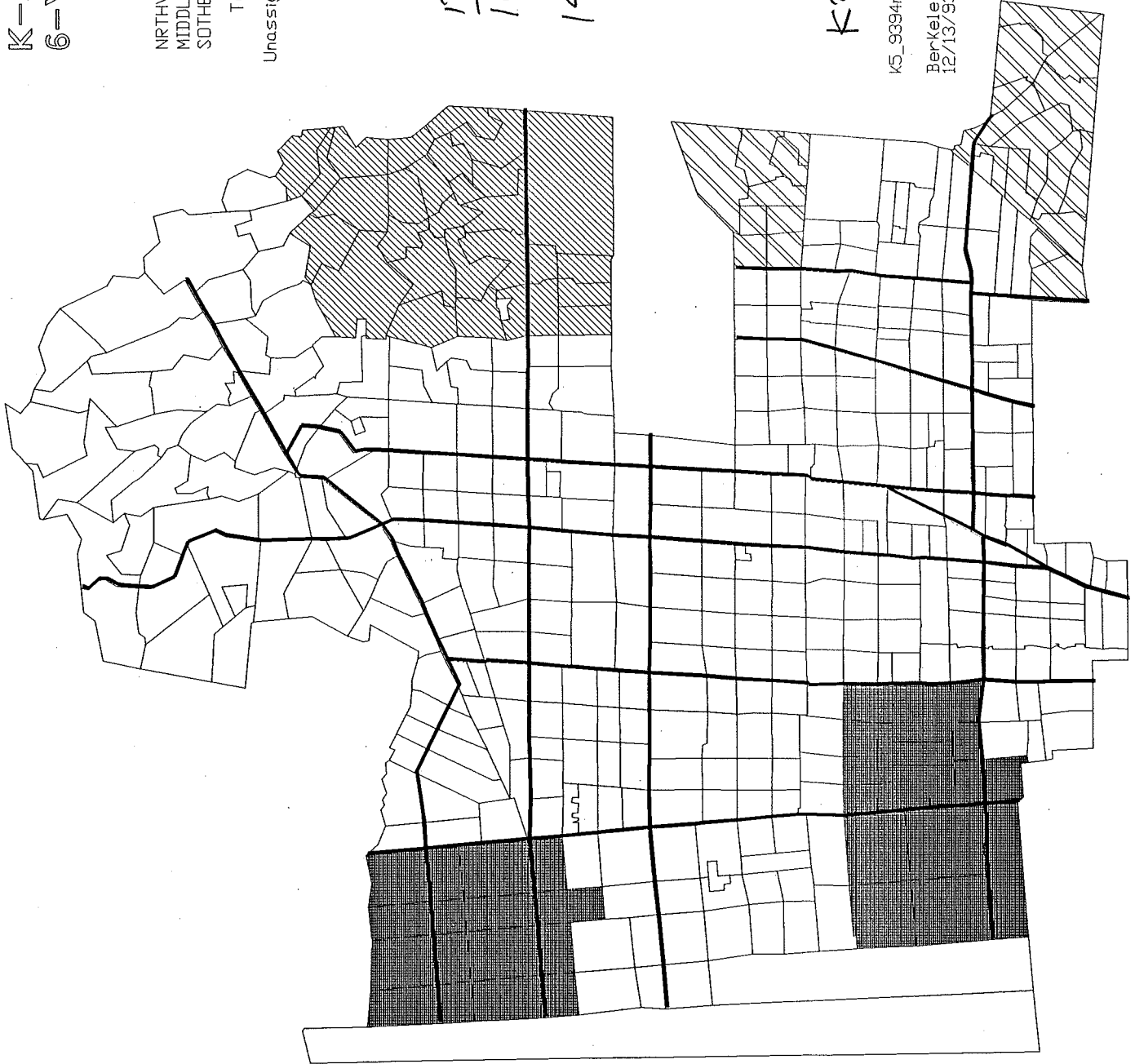

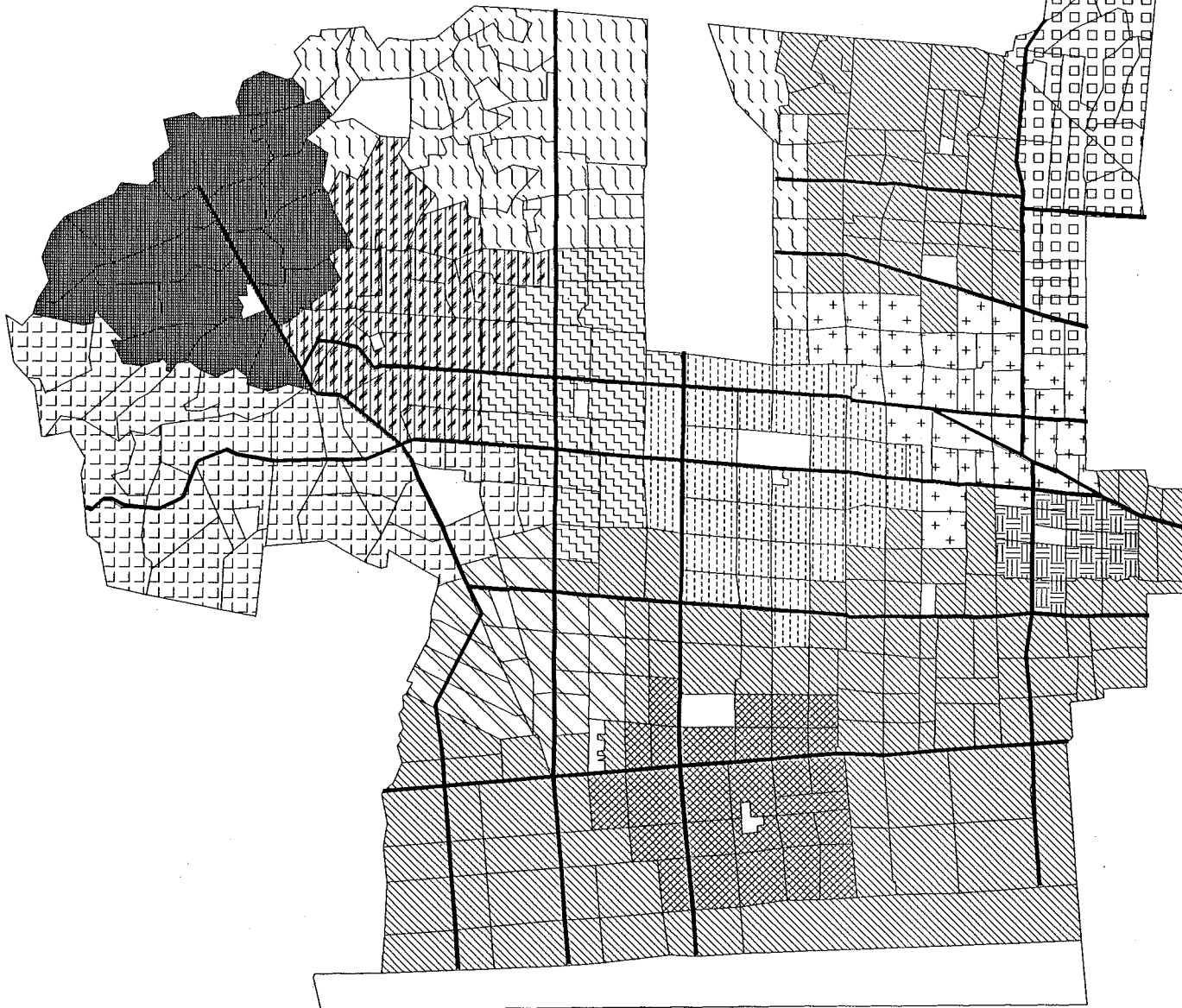
